Salto Gymnastics Club is a local non-profit athletics club based in Sherwood Park, Alberta. We have been offering recreational and competitive gymnastics programming in the Sherwood Park community since 1980. Some of our athletes have gone on to have success at provincial, national, and international levels. In addition to our gymnastics programming, we also offer a licensed preschool program. Our preschool program is unique as it provides students with the foundational aspects of early childhood learning, while incorporating a gymnastics element into the curriculum. Currently, our club provides services to approximately 1050 individuals, representing approximately 850 families from across our community.

This year, from March 7th to 11th, we will be hosting a 'Gymnastics in the Park' event at Millenium Place. This is a large-scale gymnastics event that will be attracting athletes from across western Canada (British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan). This event will be bringing a large influx of people to Sherwood Park, which in turn, will help provide a boost to the local tourism and hospitality community. In addition, our event will provide Sherwood Park residents with an opportunity to attend a provincial gymnastics competition in their own community. In total, we expect to have approximately 3000+ individuals attend the event over the four-day period.

As a non-profit entity, we rely on the generous contributions from the community to help us achieve our goals. As such, we would like to submit an application for Council Priority Funds. We strongly believe that our event meets the criteria for this particular funding program, as it is a large event that will help benefit the Sherwood Park community, especially from a tourism, hospitality, and recreation perspective. For this event, one of our biggest expenses has been the costs incurred as a result of procuring the necessary equipment. Therefore, we would like to formally ask for \$3000 to help us cover the cost of equipment rental for the event. In exchange for this funding, we would proudly identify Strathcona County as a sponsor. I have attached the formal application form, as well as our budget.
