Transportation Engineering and Operations provides oversight and project management for construction projects on behalf of Recreation Parks and Culture for various open space elements, such as landscaping, gazebos, new trails, and park spaces.

Operations

Includes asphalt and gravel road maintenance, spot concrete repairs, and trail maintenance. Also includes maintenance techniques such as crack sealing, spray patching, and micro surfacing to prolong the lifespan of road surfaces.

Traffic signal improvements

Construction and maintenance of various traffic signal elements.

<u>Traffic safety improvements</u>

Construction of various traffic management and pedestrian safety elements.

Communication Plan
