

Long-term License Anishnawbe Giikenimowgaywin

Report Purpose

To seek Council approval on a long-term License Agreement between Strathcona County and Anishnawbe Giikenimowgaywin.

Recommendation

THAT a long-term License Agreement, including terms 1 to 7 as set out below in the October 29, 2019 Planning and Development Services report, with Anishnawbe Giikenimowgaywinm, on the lands Plan 902 0134, Lot B (SW 18-51-21-W4), be approved.

Report

Anishnawbe Giikenimowgaywin's vision and mission is to provide a service that incorporates Anishnawbe cultural teachings, stories and songs into workshops and programming in order to raise cultural awareness and understanding as well as promote healing, inclusion and relationships; and to be recognized world-wide as an Aboriginal-based organization dedicated to promoting community connection and cultural sensitivity.

Anishnawbe Giikenimowgaywin is a new organization in the County and recently received a \$50,000.00 Social Framework Core Grant through Family and Community Services with a focus on holistic healing informed by sacred practices.

In an effort to support the group's vision, administration has agreed to consider entering into a long-term license on municipal lands.

The standard form license agreement will be the basis of the agreement with additional conditions added that incorporate the needs of the group. The general principles of the license agreement include:

- 1. Nominal rent
- 2. Term of 10 years with an option to renew for a further 10-year period
- 3. Termination provisions
- 4. Indemnity and insurance
- 5. Uses permitted
- 6. Tenant responsibilities
- 7. Surrender of the land upon expiry of the term
