Commemorative Names Registry Task Force final report

Report Purpose

To provide the Priorities Committee with the final report of the Commemorative Names Registry Task Force.

Report

Strathcona County established the Task Force on October 25, 2022, under the authority of Bylaw 56-2022 Commemorative Names Registry Task Force.

The mandate of the Task Force was to:

- Review the current Strathcona County Commemorative Names Registry and investigate and propose additional people that should be added to the Strathcona County Commemorative Names Registry.
- Work with administration on proposed updates to the Commemorative Names Registry portion of Policy SER-008-011 Naming of Development Area, Roads, Parks, and Public Facilities.
- Provide a report with names and brief biographies of proposed additions to the Commemorative Names Registry to Council by end of March 2024.

The Task Force was comprised of six public members, one member of Council, one alternate member of Council, and the Mayor as an ex-officio member. The Task Force has completed their mandate and was disbanded on April 9, 2024.

April 9, 2024	A report was discussed in Closed Session.
March 14, 2023	Council approved amendments to Bylaw 56-2022 Commemorative Names Registry Task Force to change the deadline for the final report from June 2023 to March 2024.
Oct. 25, 2022	Council gave three readings to Bylaw 56-2022 Commemorative Names Registry Task Force.
Sept. 27, 2022	Council approved that by the end of October 2022, administration prepare, for Council's consideration, a bylaw and any necessary documents for the establishment of a Council Advisory Task Force, with a proposed membership of five to seven public members, one Councillor, one alternate and the Mayor as an ex-officio member.
