### 2023 Off-Site Development Levies Annual Report

### **Report Purpose**

To present the 2023 Off-Site Development Levies Annual Report, compiled to comply with the requirements under the Municipal Government Act.

### Report

The 2023 Off-Site Development Levies Annual Report provides a full disclosure of all levy costs and payments collected by Strathcona County. It has been prepared in accordance with Section 9 of the *Municipal Government Act* Off-Site Levies Regulation (187/2017) and provides an account of levies collected by facilities or infrastructure type including wastewater, storm, water, arterial and rural roads.

The County exercises its authority to collect off-site levies through the approval and update of off-site development levy bylaws. The bylaws are updated by utilizing an established and formalized process led by the Planning and Development Services department. The bylaws describe the types of facilities or infrastructure the County collects levies for and defines the levy rates for the year.
