

Hearthstone at Cambrian Stage 1 park naming (Ward 4)

Report Purpose

To provide information to Council to make a decision on a proposed park name within Hearthstone at Cambrian Stage 1.

Recommendation

THAT the park name "Hearthside Park", as set out in Enclosure 3 of the October 22, 2024 Planning and Development Services report, be approved.

The developer of Hearthstone at Cambrian is proposing to name the small unprogrammed park immediately east of the Crestview Terrace Bridge within Stage 1 of the development as "Hearthside Park".

The proposed name is consistent with the naming theme of Hearthstone at Cambrian.

Council approved the road name "Helen Lavender Lane", as set out in Enclosure 3 of the May 17, 2022 Planning and Development Services report.

December 7, 2021 Council approved:

- 1. the name "Hearthstone at Cambrian" for the development area to the east of Old Man Creek within the Cambrian Crossing ASP, as set out in Enclosure 3 of the December 7, 2021 Planning and Development Services Report.
- 2. the name "Helen Lavender Park" for the Cambrian East Stage 1 park, as set out in Enclosure 4 of the December 7, 2021 Planning and Development Services Report.
- 3. the names "Hearthstone Boulevard", "Old Man Creek Boulevard", "Stoneside Road" and "Cornerstone Way" for the Cambrian East Stage 1 roads as set out in Enclosure 4 of the December 7, 2021 Planning and Development Services report.
