

### Property Tax Relief - Roll 8130002005

# **Report Purpose**

To bring forward a request for cancellation of penalties imposed.

#### Recommendation

THAT a cancellation request for 2024 penalties imposed in the amount of \$893.08 pertaining to roll number 8130002005, be denied.

# Report

The request relates to penalties imposed due to the property owner not paying property taxes by June 28, 2024.

In their letter to Council provided in Enclosure 1, the property owner explains they were away for 70 days completing a charity run from Sherwood Park to Victoria during the tax payment deadline. It's further explained they believed their property tax payments were built into their mortgage.

Bylaw 46-2011 outlines late payment penalty dates and amounts. For the 2024 tax year, Strathcona County applied roughly 3,100 penalties to properties based on non-payment by the June 28, 2024 deadline. Cancellation or refunds of penalties are denied by administration unless the County has erred on the tax notice.

Administration recommends the cancellation request of penalties in the amount of \$893.08 be denied as this situation does not meet any of the categories within the Property Tax Relief Policy included in Enclosure 2.
