## Open House and Engagement



Project website published on April 25, 2023 to provide an overview of the project and fill out surveys to gather information. This FIRST survey was completed by 108 individuals. BGC mailed 1,439 postcards to nearby residents to provide them with the building proposal website address and information about the open house on May 12, 2023.

BGC hosted a station-style Open House from 6:00-9:00 at Brentwood Elementary School on June 13, 2023.

In attendance: Mayor Rod Frank, Councilor Lorne Harvey, Councilor Bill Tonita, BGC Board, environmentalists, designers, mediation and consultation, BGC Staff, SC Admin Surveys were accessible by all either via their personal device, paper, or by computers provided.

Approximately 90 attended the Open House. 80 individuals filled out this SECOND survey.

The What We Heard Report was sent to Strathcona County Administration to review.





## Environmental Studies

- November 2023 BGC Strathcona County hired GreenPlan Wildlife Biologists.
- Wildlife biologists ensured all proposals and conditions are in accordance with the Federal Migratory Bird Act and its requirements.

BGC Strathcona County is committed to ensuring trees, habitat, and land are part of an environmentally responsible build.




## Where We Are

In the Summer of 2024, the Federal Government unexpectedly announced a third intake of the GICB funding.

- Applications opened September 2024 and close October 16, 2024.
- BGC submitted an application at the beginning of October.
- BGC Strathcona County has current pending applications for over \$13 million in provincial and federal funding.
