Housing Affordability Strategy – housing uses

Report Purpose

To provide the Priorities Committee with an update on actions to increase opportunities for supportive housing uses.

Report

The Strathcona County Housing Affordability Strategy was approved by Council in April of 2024. Action item 1.4 of the strategy provides direction to increase opportunities for supportive housing uses by reducing the number of different terms used for what would be considered the same or similar forms of housing to reduce stigma-driven land use conflicts and regulate the use, rather than the user.

The existing Land Use Bylaw has several overlapping uses which take the same or similar forms. The duplication within multiple definitions can cause confusion and result in uses that are obsolete.

Planning and Development Services has prepared an update regarding potential amendments to the Land Use Bylaw that aim to consolidate uses which assume the same or similar forms. This will resolve existing duplications, remove terms that are outdated or associated with stigma and provide clarity to potential applicants.

Consultation regarding supportive housing occurred with stakeholders during the creation of the Housing Affordability Strategy. Members of the public will have an opportunity to speak directly to Council regarding the proposed amendments at a future public hearing.
