## **Agricultural Framework update**

### **Report Purpose**

## Report

Through 2024, we have reflected upon and refreshed our agricultural priorities. With the various strategies and programs developed and implemented via the Agriculture Master Plan, reflecting on relevant current issues and trends, our legislated duties, our corporate strategic priorities and plans, several new priorities have come to light.

The Agricultural Framework supports a coordinated approach between administrative departments and external stakeholders, by enabling them to work together, leveraging people and financial resources, and responding to community needs in context of our strategic priorities and legislated duties. Refreshed themes have clear outcomes and specific objectives identified that prioritize

- 1. Governance and Agriculture
- 2. People Engaged in Agriculture
- 3. Agriculture Business Retention and Expansion
- 4. Agriculture Production

In order to tell our story, outcomes and objectives were quantified for each theme by documenting:

- **Innovative practices** current procedures, processes and programs
- Supportive tools current plans, policies, directives, bylaws, and standards
- **Strategic initiatives** new plans, procedures, processes, programs, policies, directives, bylaws, or standards that focus on change

## Agricultural Framework Collaboration Team (ACT)

To assist Planning and Development Services in the development and ultimate implementation of the Framework, the ACT consists of those department representatives that have already identified strategic initiatives documented within the Framework and those that are actively working within the themes. This cross-departmental group has worked together across professions, departments and disciplines to support agriculture – ensuring programs, activities and collaborative initiatives are documented to contribute

The purpose of ACT is to facilitate implementation of the Framework. The Terms of Reference defines roles and responsibilities of the department representatives including:

- ensure up-to-date documentation of programs, plans, policies, and strategic initiatives
- ensure coordination of programs, plans, policies, and strategic initiatives between departments and external stakeholders
- assist with research and identification of grants and funding opportunities
- support the annual Agricultural Framework reporting
- provide strategic initiative recommendations to Executive Team and Council

It has become apparent during our reflection that we have been actively, but not collectively, supporting our agricultural community. In order to tell our story accurately and robustly, it is important to document and recognize the work to date and realize new initiatives to continue to support agriculture at all levels. This proposed Framework will change our language to better align with the documents purpose and contribute to the strategic goals in a more direct way.
