Report

Strathcona County residents benefit from several support services offered by community groups affiliated with the RCMP and Enforcement Services. Highlighted below are some of the key programs:

1. Victim Services Unit

- Emotional support to individuals who have experienced trauma
- Information and guidance victim rights, available resources (counseling services), and the criminal justice process (criminal court assistance, restraining orders, and liaising with crown prosecutors)
- Practical assistance form completion (medical/financial), shelters/food/transportation services, emergency safety planning, legal aid, and other community services

2. Citizens on Patrol

- Neighbourhood patrols
- Speed watch
- Impaired driving carts
- Community event support

3. Crime Watch

- Neighborhood watch programs
- Crime prevention education
- Fraud alerts and awareness campaigns

These community group support services benefit the residents of Strathcona County by enhancing safety and security, providing mental health and well-being support, fostering community engagement, granting access to resources, and supporting crime prevention through education, awareness, and proactive measures. Ongoing collaboration and support of these programs are crucial for preserving the high quality of life that our community values.
