# 2025-2026 RCMP Annual Policing Priorities

### **Report Purpose**

To provide information to Priorities Committee and to request recommendation for approval of the 2025-2026 RCMP Annual Performance Plan Priorities.

#### Report

Article 6.1 of the Municipal Police Service Agreement (MPSA) stipulates that the elected head of the municipality may set the objectives, priorities and goals of the municipal police service (RCMP), not inconsistent with those identified by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Services, in concert with the annual RCMP planning cycle.

  - d. Mental Health Presentations 8 Presentations
- 3. Drug Enforcement
  - a. Education and Awareness Presentations 15 Presentations
  - b. Drug Projects 15 Projects
  - c. Drug Related Media Releases 10 Releases
- 4. Traffic Safety and Impaired Driving
  - a. Officer Violator Contacts 25,000 Ticket/Warnings
  - b. Impaired Driving Checkstops 30 Checkstops
  - c. Impaired Charges & IRS Sanctions 75 Charges/Sanctions
