

- **#1: Family violence and crimes against persons** 70% chose as 1st, 2nd or 3rd choice (excludes unranked)
- **#2: Major property crime & minor property crime** 69% chose as 1st, 2nd or 3rd choice (excludes unranked)
- #3: Illegal drug offences 50% (↑ 4% YoY)
- #4: Impaired Driving 48% (↑ 3% YoY)
- #5: Fraud and other financial crimes 25% (12% YoY)
- #6: Traffic enforcement 19% (1% YoY)
- #7: Youth engagement and development 15% (↑3% YoY)
- #8: Community engagement 13% (³% YoY)
