

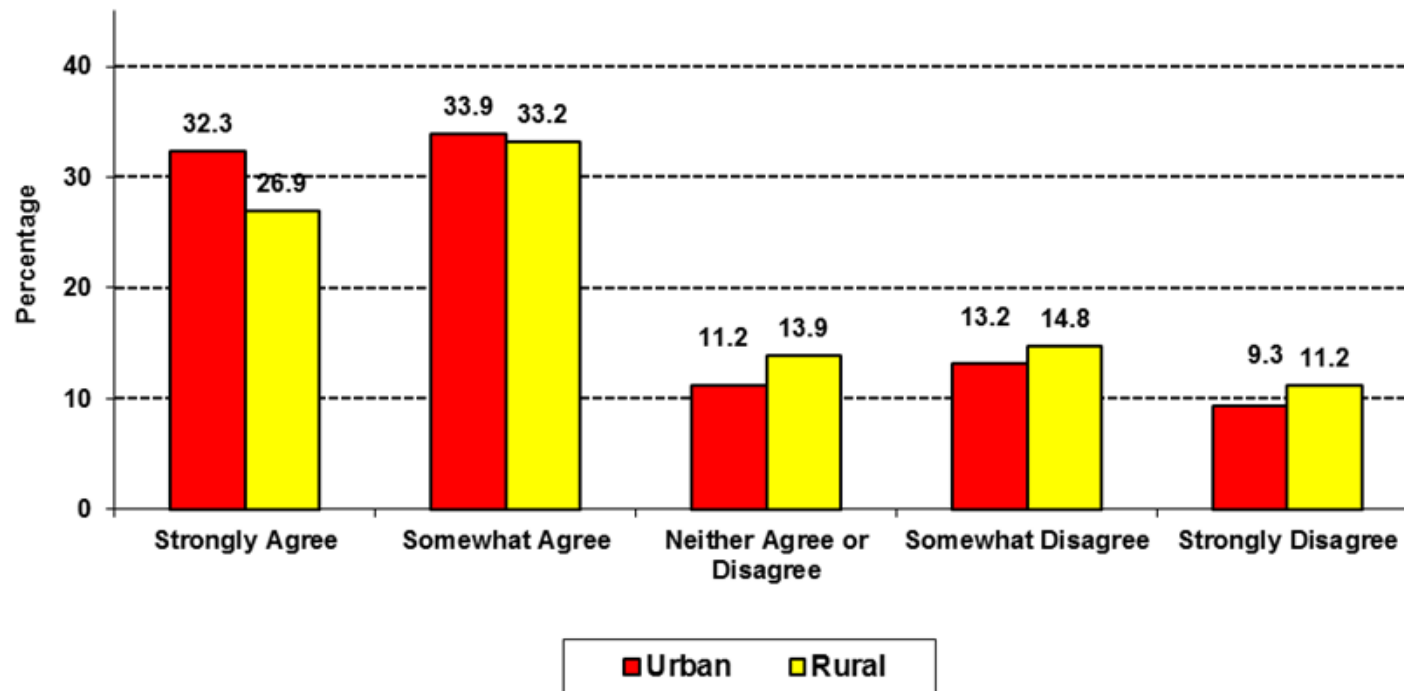

# Background

# Background

- January 2014- Neighbourhood Traffic Safety Strategy
  - 3 recommendations
    - Increase Resident Engagement in RTS
    - Increase Public Education for RTS
    - Form School Traffic Safety Partnership

# Purpose of Action Plan

- Identify some concrete actions that can be taken to address ongoing challenges in residential traffic management:
  - High demand for residential enforcement
  - Inconsistent speed limits and signage
  - Increasing speeds
- Identify actions that are sustainable and effective in meeting resident expectations

# Development of Action Plan

- First draft with recommended actions has been developed based on:
  - History of resident concerns
  - 2013 and 2015 Traffic Safety Survey results
  - Lessons learned in previous traffic calming initiatives
  - Best practice

# Public Engagement

- Establish a vision of a livable community from a residential traffic safety perspective
- Gauge resident response to the proposed actions
- Utilize a two-way dialogue process

# Timelines

- Public Engagement – late September/ October, 2016
- Bring forward completed Action Plan in Q1 2017
