In the adult category, 44 artists submitted artwork for a total of 71 artworks. The recommended purchases for the 2025 Annual Art Acquisition program totals \$17,877. \$11,747 will be provided through the operational budget for 2025 and \$6,130 will be allocated from the public art reserves to address diversity gaps. These pieces will be displayed in the Artrium for a year and then placed throughout various Strathcona County facilities.
