Report Purpose

Report

The 2024 Off-Site Development Levies Annual Report provides full disclosure of all levy costs and payments collected by Strathcona County.

Prepared in accordance with Section 9 of the Municipal Government Act Off-Site Levies Regulation (187/2017), the report outlines levies collected by facility or infrastructure type, including wastewater, stormwater, water, arterial roads and rural roads.

Strathcona County exercises its authority to collect off-site levies through the approval and updating of development levy bylaws. These bylaws are reviewed and amended through a formal process led by Planning and Development Services. They specify the types of infrastructure for which levies are collected and define the levy rates for the year.
