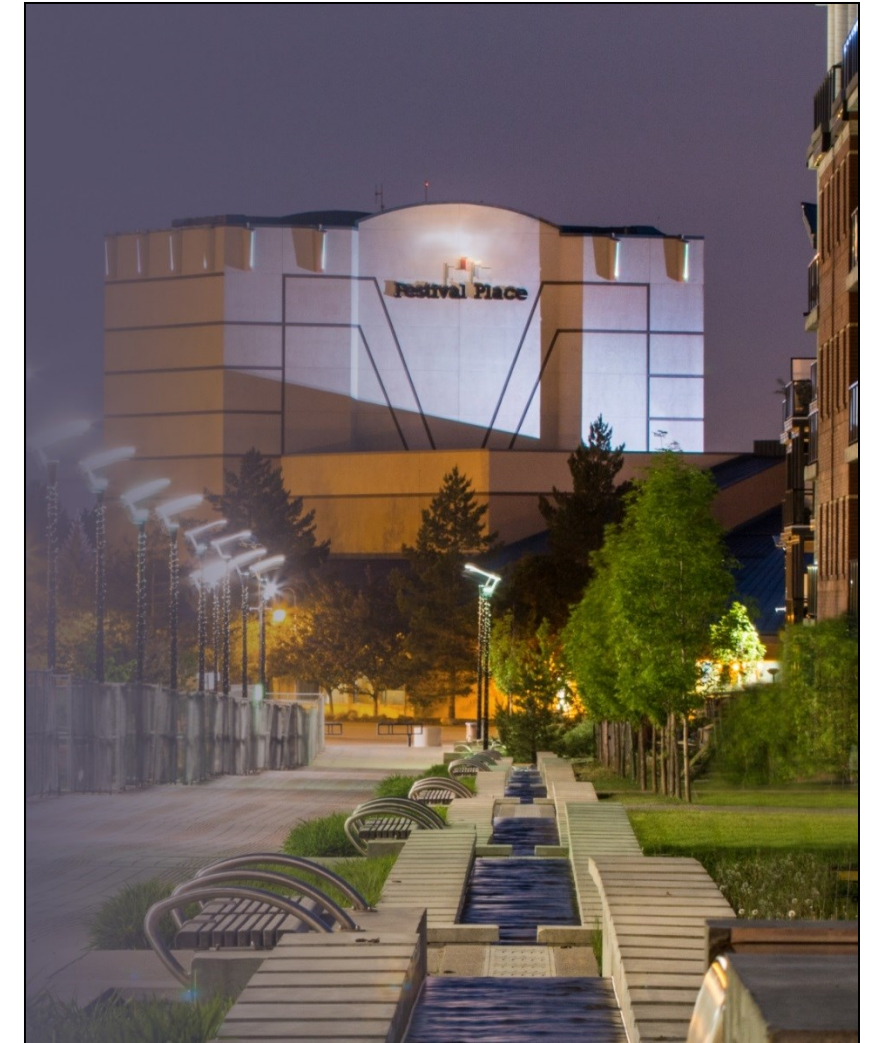

Art in the Park Program – Phase I

- 2004 Vision for public art and programming of open spaces created
- 2005/06 Prairie Walk & Volunteer Plaza completed
- 2008 Design and integration of public art and open space program initiated



Art in The Park Program – Phase II

➤ 2010 Artist team (Tricycle) and ISL engaged to design and integrate art into CITP. Three open space art pieces included:

- 1) Steel Screens (Momentum)
- 2) Rocks & Sound (Prairie Walk)
- 3) Volunteer Plaza Sculpture

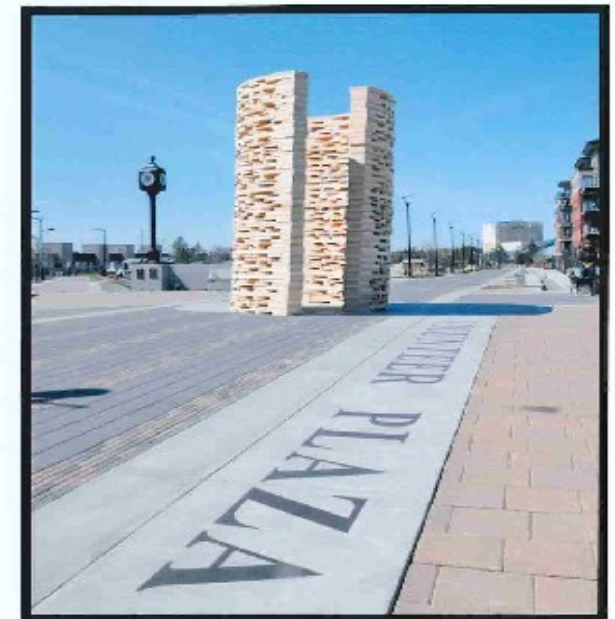
Four stainless steel screens – west plaza area of the Community Centre (Momentum)

Public Art Program

- Strathcona County's Public Art Program was approved in March 2016 (requires allocation of 1% of the total budget to public art)
- CITP's Public Art Program was initiated prior to this (3.1% of the total budget is allocated to public art)
- Artwork projects in excess of \$250,000 must be approved by Council

CITP Art in the Park Program

Summary of Costs

1. Momentum (Actual)	\$ 83,470
2. Rocks & Sound (Actual)	\$ 89,904
3. Volunteer Plaza Sculpture (Proposed)	\$700,000
Total Costs	\$893,374
