Bylaw 20-2013

- Taxi Cab Safety Bylaw 20-2013
 - Third reading: October 7, 2014
 - In effect: July 1, 2015
- Focus on safety NOT regulating the market



To date:

- 199 Taxi driver permits
- 87 Taxi vehicle permits
- > 10 companies; 3 individuals providing own service.
- 9 Taxi driver applications refused for not meeting criteria



Limitations of Bylaw 20-2013

- Changing vehicle for hire industry
 - Innovative technologies entering into the traditional taxi business model
 - New participants entering the market
- Confusion over applicability
- Enforcement difficulties
- Inconsistent with regional municipalities
- Lack of incentives for 'accessible' vehicles for hire





Highlights for Consideration

- Permits for all vehicles for hire (not just taxis)?
- Incentives to encourage more accessible vehicles for hire in Strathcona County?
- Removal of items in Bylaw 20-2013 that are now addressed by Provincial regulations?
